

Eligibility

Home Library Services are available to people living in the Strathfield local government area who are temporarily or permanently housebound due to:

- Age
- Illness or injury
- Physical or sensory impairment
- Carer responsibilities
- Living in a care facility

Applicants may be required to provide a letter from their doctor or health care professional stating their difficulty.

Do you have difficulty getting to the library due to illness or disability, or are you physically unable to carry books home?

Home Library Delivery

Strathfield Library provides a free delivery service to those who have difficulty visiting their local library. Items are selected to meet each patron's individual needs or requests, and delivered directly to their door.

Self-Select Home Delivery

Residents who are not housebound but who may experience difficulty carrying library items can have them delivered. Members of the self-select service can come into

the library, select items to borrow and then leave them at the desk. Library staff will deliver them to the resident on scheduled delivery days and collect any items for return.
